TRIENNIAL SHUTDOWN



On August 5th at approximately 8:00 a.m. the power was cut to our building for scheduled electrical maintenance every three (3) years. This is an extensive and complex undertaking that involves all our tenants, in order for them to temporarily relocate staff who work in departments that run 24/7/365. Temporary generators are brought in to ensure that any critical systems do not go down while the power is cut to the substation. Approximately 120 significant personnel were authorized to be in the building during the shutdown.
